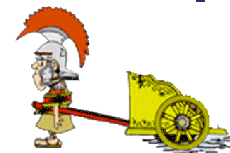




# 2nd Hatfield and 2nd Little Heath Scout Troops Programme April-July 2006

### Troop A - Rocket Building at Little Heath Church Hall

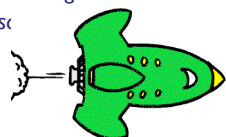
### Troop B - Rocket Building at the scout hut
