If the weather is suitable, some of the weapons employed may be a little 'damp' - you have been warned!

We'll set up some different sports on the field - football, volleyball, rounders, swingball etc - and you'll get about 20 minutes playing each sport. None is compulsory so if there's one you really didn't want to do that's not a problem!
