First week in September

First week in October

First week in November

There will also be a chance - for those that want to - to invent some fake injuries with stage blood!



First week in December

Base Building

In groups you will have the first 40 minutes of the meeting to build yourselves a base in the hut. We will then provide each team with water balloons, pistols etc and let the carnage begin...

Second week in December

Stomp/Snails/Slings & Boats

Four different activities to try over the evening. You'll be in inventing your stomp (percussion based music), racing a snail (bring your own!), making a sling shot and see who can build the fastest boat.
